

The speaker for the event was Mr. Pratik Bhadane. Head of E-Cell Collaboration Team AY 2022-23. Ms. Lekha began the session with a welcome to the speaker, and the teachers and students gathered. This was followed by a prayer song by Aishwarya Shenge, and Lekha then formally introduced the speaker for the day. She talked about a resume and the crucial importance it had in today's job situation. Pratik then took over, and introduced the audience to the core concept of a resume and what it included. He talked about the core elements of a resume, and what are the must-haves in any professional resume.

The speaker talked about the different sections in a resume, starting with information about oneself and what must be included. He went over the dos and don'ts of the introduction section, after which he moved on to talking about past experience. He briefly explained the type of work experience which must be included in the resume, and how to structure the same. He then talked about the skills one should include, and the different types of certifications which were beneficial to the overall skillset of the candidate.

He explained how skills were the most important section, and spent an extensive amount of time to talking about different skills and how best to present them. Then he moved on to projects and how and what projects must be mentioned on the resume. He discussed the ways to introduce a project you have worked on and how to write about the same. He also mentioned some critical points to be noted when making a resume, such as the content and the structuring and formatting of the content itself, and some key insights as to how recruiters look into a resume and make decisions on the candidate. He then talked about the importance of projects and how best to present them, and also discussed centralization of the code on platforms such as GitHub. He also gave tips on how best to talk about the project itself. He then talked about the accomplishments and certifications that an interviewer may be interested in, and which actually add value to the candidate profile.

Lastly, he discussed how interviewers may ask you questions about the resume, and the sections of the resume. He then opened the session for questions, where many of the students posed specific questions on the nature of the content and skills to be acquired, and what industry experts look for in a candidate. Some additional points were added by Prof. Bhagyashree, which covered some points which the speaker could not add in the session. Everyone present at the webinar got inspired by speaker and determined to carefully consider the building of a resume and the skills they wished to acquire for the future. The session ended with Vote of Thanks from Prof. Shailaja, who also talked about the speaker and reflected on his journey from student to such an insightful resource person. All the queries posed by the students were answered, and the feedback form was shared as well. Truly, this session from E-Cell XIE Committee 2022-2023 was an inspiring event.
