

MANOR OUTREACH PROGRAM

A group of 11 students(7boys & 4girls) from SE-IT went for outreach program from 8th March to 10th March to a village called Manor in Palghar,to teach the children of **Shanti SevaAshram**.The students left the college from the afternoon of 8th and reached Manor in the evening of the same day.

The team were divided into boys and girls. Girls went to Jyoti Niwas to conduct sessions for girls from std 1st to 9th and boys took the sessions for Ashram boys from std 2nd to 9th on 8th of March. The children were divided into groups according to their standards and assigned to each person from the outreach group.The lectures were commenced on the same day, the students from SE-IT taught the children in Manor subjects like Maths,Computer and English from 6:30 till dinner time.After dinner an interactive session was conducted where they were informed about the drawing competition that was planned to be conducted on the following day.

On the morning of 9th March,the lectures began at 9:00 am where the outreach group continued with their regular sessions of Maths and English.The session continued until lunch.After lunch there was a session conducted to the children how to present themselves in English whereas the regular session continued. Same on the girls side the activity like passing the ball was played and whoever is holding the ball when the music is stopped has to say Myself in English. Computer sessions were conducted and motivational story for the girls. Maths lectures were taken for them and told to clear their doubts. After some interactions the girls were free to talk and share their problems. On the same day a drawing competition was organized where children were given a platform to showcase their talent of drawing.The drawings were judged by Fr.James and the top 2 students were facilitated by Fr.James and the rest of the children were provided with stationary as a participation gift.The group had dinner along with children. The children of Shanti Seva Ashram and Jyoti Niwas feel connected to our group members. At the end there was DJ organized for the children to enjoy and feel them good .

On the final day,the session was continued, boys and girls taught Maths to 8th and 9th std students till lunch.A small closing ceremony was held where the children gave the speech and thanked the group for their efforts and gave some blessings. The children loved and enjoyed this sessions conducted by outreach group. Thus ending the 3 day outreach programwith a vision to spread the stories of the ashram to the outside world so that the children living there should get good education and better facilities.
