In collaboration with Xavier Institute of Engineering, Mr. Claude Colaco and his family have established this scholarship fund in memory of Mr. Claude Colaco's parents to assist with the skilling, up-skilling, and re-skilling of economically and socially disadvantaged students in engineering. The core objective and aim are to enable these young students to improve their economic prospects by acquiring workforce-ready skills alongside graduate / diploma studies.

It is noteworthy that Mr. Claude Colaco spent a few years with the Jesuits as a Scholastic. He completed his BE at VJTI and was a classmate of Prof. KM Kulkarni, who played a key role in implementing the Linux OS in all the labs of XIE. Mr. Colaco has established this scholarship in memory of his beloved parents, Late Mr Julian and Mrs. Ruby Colaco.

Mr. Claude has contributed Rs. 10 lakh, and the Jesuit Community of XIE has also contributed an equal amount to the Julian & Ruby Colaco Scholarship Fund. Eighty percent of the interest will be given to deserving students, and 20% of the interest will be added to the principal amount. This ensures that the scholarship amount does not diminish over time, even after 50 years, as the principal amount grows with the inflation rate. Criterion for Julian & Ruby Colaco Scholarship:

2. Any KTs held? Yes/NO. If Yes, how many? (For every KT one point will be reduced) (5 points)
3. Any projects done (BEE, Mechanics, 3D printer etc)? _____ (5 points)
4. Events actively participated at XIE (any extracurricular activities): (5 points)
5. Did you take part in any village / slum program? Teaching Slum/Village Children? If Yes, give details. (5 points)
6. Participation in Spandan /Transmission/ Sparx (mention year-wise): (10 points)

Applications will be judged by a panel of judges consisting of: Dean of Students' Welfare, Principal, HoD of Humanities, Assistant Dean of Students' Welfare, Professor who teaches BEE, Professor who teaches Mechanics.

Award will be given during the Convocation.
