A quiz event called "Game of Tech" DATE: 23/09/2022

The Technical team of the Student Council-Team Transmission had organized their first-ever event for the year, a quiz competition for the students of S.E. & T.E. called 'Game of Tech'. The competition was held in the Computer Centre from 3:30 p.m. to 5:45 p.m. In all, 16 groups participated in the quiz competition either as an individual or as a group of two to three members.

The event began at 3:45 p.m. with the host for the evening Mr Mervis Mascarenhas, the Assistant Technical Secretary welcoming the participants, followed by a speech by Prof. Kavita Jain, Dean of Student and Staff Welfare. The students were then introduced to the members of Transmission's team, the Technical Secretary, the Assistant Technical Secretary and the Technical admins.

The quiz, Game of Tech, was divided into two rounds; the first round was a Multiple Choice (MCQ) round on google forms and a buzzer round. The participants were given about 30 mins to answer the questions and complete the first round.

After thirty mins, while the responses of the teams were being checked the host started with the spot games in order to keep the participants engaged. Games included 'Pattern Board Game' and 'Ball in Cup'. The winners of these spot games were awarded spot prizes in the form of cash prizes. The spot prizes were worth fifty rupees. The top 6 high scorers of the first round were announced and were allowed to participate in the second round.

The second round was a buzzer round and it was hosted by Mr Ahsaas Srivastava, the Technical Secretary. This round consisted of 20 questions wherein whoever knew the answer had to press the buzzer and answer the questions. This round had negative markings for wrong answers. This round was concluded with two bonus questions for spot prizes.
