

ADMISSION PROCESS AND THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

FIRST YEAR ADMISSION

The First year Engineering admission process shall have the following two categories as per the rules and regulations of the State Common Entrance Test Cell (CET Cell) Maharashtra and Autonomous Institute under University of Mumbai, they are:

1. Students applying for admission through Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) of The State Common Entrance Test Cell (CET Cell) :

Students shall apply for admission to the State Common Entrance Test Cell (CET Cell), on-line as per CET Cell's notification in the leading newspapers and their website. The eligibility criteria for admission are as specified in the Information Brochure issued by the CET Cell for that particular academic year. Normally the Academic Year starts from June-July of every year and ends in the next year of May-June. CET Cell shall release the document i.e., the information brochure and the rules and regulation hand book in the month of April-May every year. This process is referred as online admission.

2. Students applying for admission to Institute Level Quota seats:

Students seeking admission to XIE directly at the Institute will have to make an application in the prescribed format of XIE, against the advertisements released in the leading newspapers published by the



Institute XIE. The starting date and the ending date of filling up of the application form and submitting them along with the required documents at the College General Office shall be specified in the newspaper. The advertisement for admission to the 1st/2nd year of the Institute Level Quota seats shall appear in the leading newspapers in May-June, every year. This process is also referred as off-line admission.

However, the eligibility criterion of admission for first year engineering either through CAP of online process or to the institute level quota seats of off-line process remains the same as given below:

i. Eligibility Criteria for Maharashtra State Candidates:

Normally students who have passed the H.S.C. (Std. XII) Examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination and secured generally a minimum of 45% of marks in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics taken together,

AND

Having appeared for the MHT-CET Examination conducted by the Competent Authority of the Government of Maharashtra and having secured a minimum qualifying mark as specified by CET Cell are eligible to take the admission.

**** Note:-** However, the scores of 45% in Physics, Chemistry and Maths taken together at Standard XII, may be varied by CET Cell from time to time and year to year.



ii. Eligibility Criteria for Outside Maharashtra State Candidates:

Students who have passed Std. XII or an equivalent examination of any recognized Board with a minimum of 45% marks in the subject of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics taken together,

AND

Having appeared for the MHT-CET/AIEEE/JEE mains or advanced examination of Central Board/IIT, and secured a minimum qualifying mark, as specified by CET Cell, Maharashtra/Central Board of AIEEE/JEE of IIT are eligible for admission. Such students' who have passed their XIIth from other boards other than Maharashtra State Board must produce the Domicile Certificate of Maharashtra of either of the parents (Father/Mother) and the student. Hence, the students shall confirm the stand taken by the CET Cell looking at their brochure and the website in this regard.

However, all the rules and regulations specified in the Information Brochure published by the CET Cell and also the notices that are put up on their website www.mahacet.org are totally applicable for all the above said types of admissions.

**** Note:-** However, the scores of 45% in Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics taken together at std XII, may be varied by CET Cell from time to time and year to year.

After completion of all the rounds of admissions that are carried out by the CET Cell and the last day specified for reporting to the respective Institute for all such students who have been allotted with a CAP seat is accepted and confirmed by paying the fee, the seats remaining vacant shall be filled up by the Institute (XIE) as per the admission rules and regulations notified by CET Cell and the Government of Maharashtra.



iii. Students who are applying after completing their Diploma course in Engineering / Technology, or after completing B.Sc., degree with PCM as major :

The eligibility criteria for students who have passed their Diploma/B.Sc., degree course is, as specified in the Information Brochure for that particular academic year issued by the State Common Entrance Test Cell (CET Cell).

In General, the Diploma holders who have passed their Diploma course in Engineering/Technology with a minimum of 45% marks with English as their medium of instruction from any of the Polytechnics affiliated to MSBTE or its equivalent /AICTE approved autonomous Polytechnics /Board situated in or outside the Maharashtra State are eligible for admission to first year.

Further, those candidates who have passed their B.Sc., Science with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics as their major subjects of study and obtained 45% marks aggregate in the subjects of PCM taken together and having taken English as their medium of instruction are also eligible for first year engineering,
