ADMISSION PROCEDURE:-

Candidates whose names appear in the Final Merit List are hereby informed that the admission process shall be conducted strictly on the basis of merit, as per the schedule given above.

Candidates are advised to attend the admission process along with their parent/guardian. Candidates are required to be present at the scheduled time. Failure to remain present at the scheduled time may result in loss of candidature, and the seat may be offered to the next eligible candidate in the merit list.

Candidates reporting late shall not be considered for the ongoing admission round. Their candidature may be considered in a subsequent round, subject to the availability of seats and the applicable admission rules.

Candidates are required to bring the following documents in original, along with two sets of photocopies of the documents, at the time of admission.

1. MHT-CET Score Card
2. HSC Marksheet
3. SSC Marksheet
4. Application Registration printout of CAP (FC).
5. Leaving Certificate
6. APAAR Id print out
7. Certificate of Indian Nationality OR Indian Passport in the name of the candidate OR College Leaving Certificate indicating the Nationality as 'Indian' OR Birth Certificate issued by appropriate Authorities
8. Maharashtra State Domicile Certificate OR Birth Certificate indicating Birth Place in Maharashtra OR College Leaving Certificate indicating Birth Place in Maharashtra.
9. Aadhaar Card
10. Physical / Medical Fitness Certificate from a registered Medical Practitioner
11. Gap Certificate if applicable.

Candidates who have already secured admission elsewhere shall produce admission letter from that admitted Institute or a certificate from the Head of that Institute in which admission is secured, stating that the candidate has secured admission in the said institution and that his/her originals of the aforesaid documents shown at Sr. Nos. (1) to (5) is being retained by the Institute. Such candidates shall produce attested copies of documents shown in Sr. Nos. (1) to (8) duly attested by that Head of the institution where admission has been secured.

The payment of fees for the seat allotted through ILS vacant seats will be Rs. 199000/- + up to 2/3 times (college fees) it may vary as per the final decision of the College Managing Authority after counselling along with Rs. 2000/- (college form processing fees)

Candidates who are offered admission and decide to accept the admission are required to pay the prescribed fees on the spot by cheque in favour of “**Xavier Institute of Engineering**”.
