
Microsoft SQL training and internship program was carried out under Mr. Chirag Panchal from CMP Infotech for the registered students in the course. The lectures began on 8th February, 2021 with lectures scheduled on monday, wednesday and friday. The learning began with introduction to basic programming concepts of Database with the help of SQL Server which is a relational database management system from Microsoft.

The training was carried out using SQL programming language used for Relational Database System. Concepts on SQL programming such as concept of RDBMS, Introduction and component of SQL server were taught in depth to the students. The students were given examples with use cases and time to practice out their own understanding of the concepts by the faculty.

The next part of the training included Basic data types also Creating databases and tables. After that students were studied about the SQL queries i.e. Select, Insert, Delete, Update & Alter table queries with the Select--Where clause. In the next session there was Concatenation and Calculation concept of columns, then various types of operators.

In overall session, students studied that the system is designed and built is to manage and store information also It supports various business intelligence operations, analytic operations and transaction processing

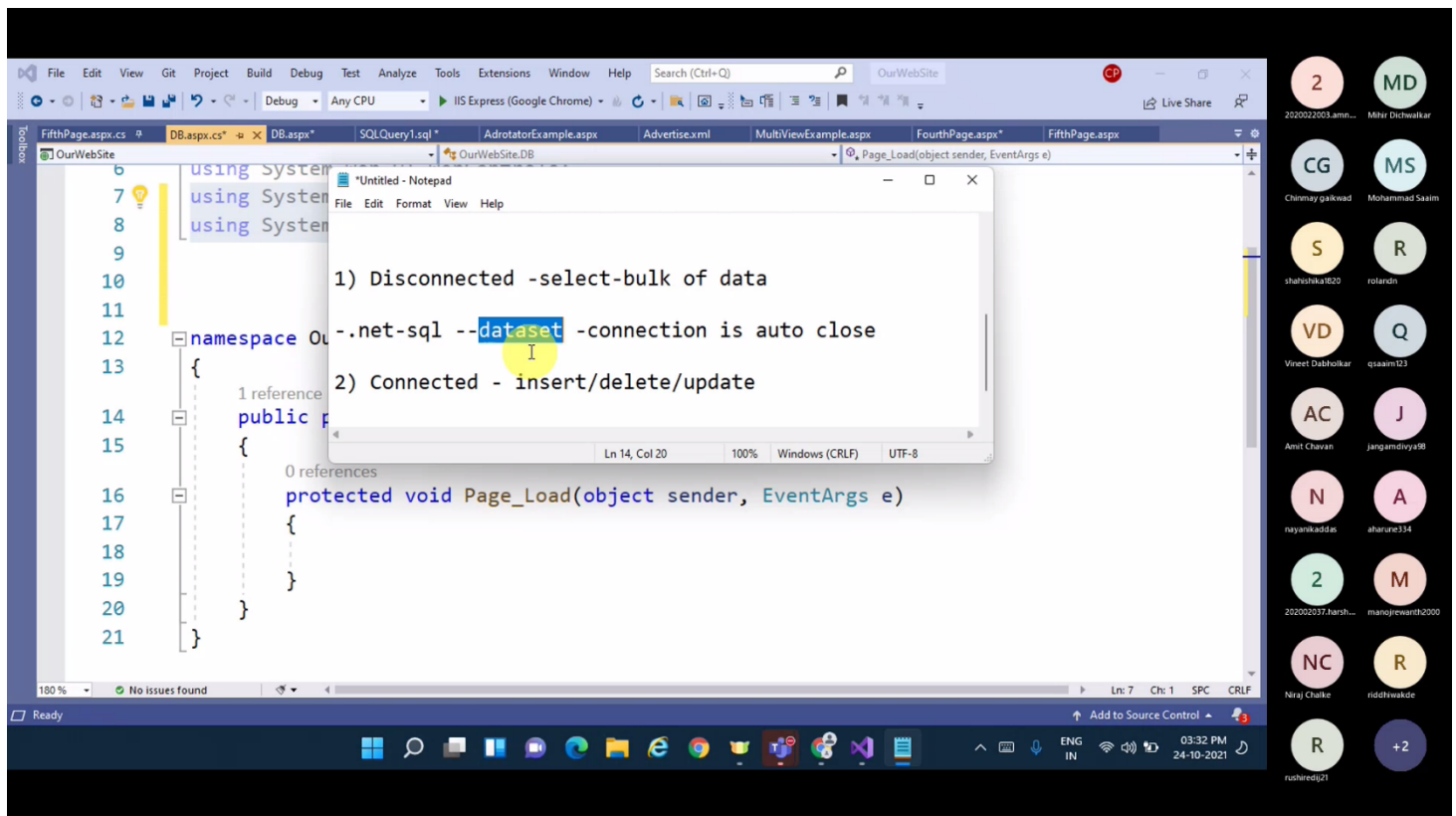
