
Dr Thomas Schwarz SJ Scholarship for Python Scholars



It is a pleasure to inform all second-year engineering students of Xavier Institute of Engineering (XIE) that it will provide scholarships to students who are outstandingly proficient in Python programming. Fr Dr Thomas Schwarz was the one who first encouraged students and faculty members to learn Python for data science and AI and ML. As a pioneer in the field of Python programming, XIE offers this scholarship in his name in appreciation of what he has done.

Dr Schwarz has trained XIE faculty members in Python-based subjects. It is his strong belief that evaluation should be based on projects. Hence, the quality of the python based project is used for evaluating student performance. He has also written a text book, *Joy of Python*, for the high school students in India, and many of the Jesuit Schools in Mumbai have already adopted *Joy of Python* as the text book for VII-IXth Standards.

This scholarship is awarded every academic year to the ones that carried out the top three projects. It will be awarded in the form of a cash prize of up to ₹10,000, and it will be determined by the Schwarz Scholarship Committee (SSC) made up of faculty members from each department at XIE, and handed out by either the Principal or Director.
