All students belonging to SC, ST, OBC, SBC, VJ, NT, EBC and Minority (Muslim, Buddhist, Christian, Sikh, Parsi, Jain and Jews Community) are hereby informed that according to their specific category of eligibility they should fill online application form for the below mentioned department-wise Scholarship Scheme on https://mahadbt.maharashtra.gov.in (Aaple Sarkar DBT Portal)

1) Social Justice and Special Assistance Department

(Applicable for SC students admitted through CAP round only)

- > Government of India Post-Matric Scholarship
 - ❖ Candidate family income should be less than or equal to 2,50,000/-.
 - ❖ They must produce Income Certificate Provided by Tahesildar and Domicile certificate of Candidate.

> Post-Matric Tuition Fee and Examination Fee (Freeship)

- Candidate family annual income above Rs. 2,50,000/- without any upper limit.
- ❖ They must produce Income Certificate Provided by Tahesildar and Domicile certificate of Candidate.

2) Tribal Development Department

(Applicable for ST students admitted through CAP round only)

- > Post Matric Scholarship Scheme (Government of India)
 - ❖ Family annual income <= 2,50,000/=.</p>
 - ❖ They must produce Income Certificate Provided by Tahesildar and Domicile certificate of Candidate.

> Tuition Fee and Exam Fee for Tribal Students (Freeship)

- ❖ Family annual income limit > 2,50,000/=.
- ❖ They must produce Income Certificate Provided by Tahesildar and Domicile certificate of Candidate.

3) Directorate of Technical Education

(Applicable for students admitted through CAP round only)

- Rajarshi Chhatrapati Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulkh Shishyavrutti Yojna(EBC)
 - Scholarship is available for open or general category students of Maharashtra.
 - Annual income of the family must be up to 8 Lakh.
 - ❖ They must produce Income Certificate Provided by Tahesildar and Domicile certificate of Candidate.
 - Only 2 child from family are allowed for benefit of scheme

Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Vasatigruh Nirvah Bhatta Yojna For child of Registered Labor / Alpabhudharak (Marginal Land Holder)

- ❖ Annual income of the family must be up to 8 Lakh.
- ❖ They must produce Income Certificate Provided by Tahesildar and Domicile certificate of Candidate.
 - ❖ Only 2 children from family are allowed for benefit of scheme.

4) VJ, NT, OBC and SBC Welfare Department

(Applicable for students admitted through CAP round only)

Post Matric Scholarship

- ❖ Candidate family annual income should be less than or equal to Rs.1.50 Lakh.
- They must produce Income Certificate Provided by Tahesildar and Domicile certificate of Candidate

> Tuition Fees and Examination Fees

- ❖ Candidates family annual income is <u>more than</u> 1.50 Lakh and less than or equal to 8.00 Lakh.
- ❖ They must produce Income Certificate Provided by Tahesildar and Domicile certificate of Candidate.

5) Minority Development Department

Scholarship Scheme for State Minority Communities Pursuing Higher Professional Education (DTE)

Financial assistance to the meritorious students belonging to Minority Communities (Muslim, Buddhist, Christian, Sikh, Parsi, Jain & Jews Community)

- The Total Annual Income of Family / Guardian should not be more than 8 Lakhs.
- ❖ They must produce Income Certificate Provided by Tahesildar and Domicile certificate of Candidate.

How to Register Online through Aadhar Number:

Online Registration should be done through the Website: https://mahadbt.maharashtra.gov.in in the following manner:

- > Step 1) Click on Post Matric Scholarship
- Click on New Applicant Registration Button and create your Username and Password
- > Step 2) To login into Aaple Sarkar DBT Portal, Applicant has to click on "Applicant login" button by using your Username and Password.
- Step 3) Enter your Aadhaar Number and if your mobile number is registered with Aadhaar then choose the authentication type as- OTP

(If your Mobile number is not registered with Aadhaar then go to Aadhaar Centre and register your Mobile number with Aadhaar and then follow the above procedure)

- Aadhaar number is required to process the DBT benefit.
- * Applicant must possess Bank Account (In nationalized bank) in their own name and Aadhaar number should be linked with your bank account and also in NPCI mapper for receiving Direct Benefit Transfers (DBT).
- * Aadhaar seeding with NPCI mapping form is available at https://mahadbt.maharashtra.gov.in
- Minimum 80% attendance is compulsory to avail above scholarships.
