

GENERAL RULES

- Teams can consist of 2-4 members. Participants cannot be part of multiple teams.
- Participants must be registered students of the institution or as specified in the event guidelines.
- All participants must register before the hackathon starts. Late entries are not allowed.
- All code, designs, and content created during the hackathon must be original and created within the event timeline. Pre-built projects or plagiarized content will lead to disqualification.
- Prohibited Content: Projects must not include offensive, illegal, or inappropriate material.
- Team Collaboration: Teams must work independently. External help, other than approved mentors or resources, is not allowed.
- Participants can use open-source libraries, frameworks, AI, and APIs, provided proper credit is given

SECURITY RULES

- Entry Check: All participants will undergo security checks; unauthorized personnel are prohibited in restricted areas.
- Prohibited Items: Sharp objects, inflammables, narcotics, alcohol, and harmful items will be confiscated.
- Zero Tolerance for Abuse: Physical or verbal abuse will lead to disqualification.
- Property Damage: Damage to college property will result in serious consequences.
- Non-Permitted Products: Items not allowed will be confiscated and not returned.
- Valuables: Team Spandan-Transmission is not responsible for lost or damaged valuables; participants carry them at their own risk.
- Post-Event Conduct: After the event, participants will be treated as general audience members.




